Dear Homeowners:

Due to the expiration of our irrigation water use variance granted by the South Florida Water Management District (SFWMD) and the Board of Directors desire to have irrigation rules similar to those established by the SFWMD for Lee County Residents; **effective June 2, 2010, the irrigation watering days will change to:**

**Wednesday and Saturday for odd addresses and ½ the common areas.
Thursday and Sunday for even addresses and ½ the common areas.**
(The **watering times** will stay the same; **Single Family Homes are 4 a.m. to 8 a.m.**)

If you reside in a Condominium or Villa, you need not do anything; however, **Single Family Homeowners will need to re-program their irrigation controllers no later than June 1, 2010** if they want their landscaping to receive two watering days the first week the new schedule goes into effect and thereafter.

In addition, the **run days of the lake waterators** in all but the Clubhouse Lake (which are aerators that run 24/7) **will change to Monday, Tuesday and Friday.** The **run time (7 a.m. to 6 p.m.)** will not change.

This action provides better spacing of the days that irrigation water is available for the landscaping and waterators are operating in the lakes. **This change will give Single Family Homeowners and other Associations three weekdays**, versus one weekday and two weekend days, **to schedule irrigation system inspections and repairs.**

In closing, the Board of Directors feels the above changes will aid the healthiness and aesthetics of the landscaping and lakes as well as make it easier for outside contractors when programming Heritage Cove irrigation controllers.
